

# SOLIDARITY CENTER SUMMER ORGANIZING BRIGADE TO THE PEOPLE, FOR THE PEOPLE

From July-August the Solidarity Center is organizing a “To the People, For the People” brigade to continue the fight against unemployment, budget cuts and racism. The brigade will be primarily led by high school and other youth, but is open to those who want to gain experience in organizing and have a desire to fight back.

In June the Brigade will be meeting and supporting ongoing city budget issues and opposing war.

The brigade will target the cutbacks. It will focus on one cut at a time and dedicate its work to “UNCUT” it until we turn this around. While the budget is voted on at the end of June, the City Council has the power to fund old or new projects.

The work will entail:

1. Research, flyers, posters, banners, social media, art, video and other media
2. Speaking at street meetings, postering, tabling, and door to door work
3. Strategizing discussions on how to organize and win
4. Protests of various kinds
5. Linking up with those already in struggle on that issue
6. Political education meetings
7. Reports and reviewing our work
8. Fundraising
